- accurately measure & choose a size
- cut, sew and fit a basic bodice with bust and shoulder darts
- get the right fit and ease for your figure
- accurately transfer changes to your pattern & test the final fit
- This basic bodice can be used to design or fit all other patterns
- Participants receive the full pattern & complete work for a sleeveless bodice
- Pattern sizes for misses 6-18.
- Students bring their own sewing machines
